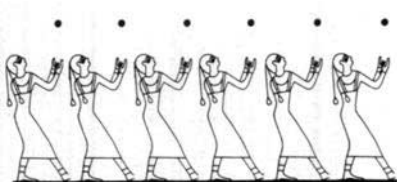


FEDERATION HALTEROPHILE INTERNATIONALE

* The annual meeting of the "*Fédération Haltérophile Internationale*" will be held on 25th August, 1972 in Munich.

* Qualifying standards for the Munich Olympic Games:

Fly-weight / up to 52 kg.: 297,5 kg.; Bantam-weight / up to 56 kg.: 322,5 kg.; Feather-weight / up to 60 kg.: 355 kg.; Light-weight / up to 67,5 kg.: 390 kg.; Middle-weight / up to 75 kg.: 425 kg.; Light-Heavy-weight / up to 82,5 kg.: 435 kg.; Middle-Heavy-weight / up to 90 kg.: 455 kg.; Heavy-weight / up to 110 kg.: 475 kg.; Superheavy-weight / over 110 kg.: 487,5 kg.



FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE HANDBALL

* The composition of the groups has been decided in Munich for the Olympic tournaments, under the presidency of Mr. Emile HORLE, President of the Technical Committee of the "*Fédération Internationale de Handball*".

Sixteen teams have qualified and have been split into four groups: group 1 - Denmark, Poland, Sweden, U.S.S.R.; group 2 - German Democratic Republic, Iceland, Czechoslovakia, Tunisia; group 3 - Germany, Spain, Norway, Rumania; group 4 - United States, Hungary, Japan, Yugoslavia.



The matches will be held in the Munich sports hall, in Augsburg, Boeblingen, Goepingen and Ulm.

FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE HOCKEY

* The hockey matches for the Olympic tournaments in Munich will be held from 27th August to 9th September.

* The Second Hockey World Cup will be organised from 24th August to 2nd September, 1973 in Amsterdam. Teams from twelve countries will take part.

* The Committee for Press and Public Relations of the "*Fédération Internationale de Hockey*" is preparing a brochure to improve the knowledge and practice of hockey in the world.

FEDERATION INTERNATIONALE DE SKI

* The 29th Congress of the "*Fédération Internationale de Ski*" will take place from 2nd to 10th June, 1973 in Famagousta and Nicosia (Cyprus).
