

Innsbruck

Two months after the IOC's choice, the Organising Committee for the XIIth Winter Games at Innsbruck 1976 has just been constituted.

Dr. Fred Sinowatz, federal minister, is the President and Dr. Alois Lugger, the Mayor of Innsbruck, has been appointed Vice President.

Dr. Karl-Heinz Klee, Secretary General, will have Mr. Frantz Wieser as his assistant.

The Organising Committee's address is at present as follows:

In accordance with IOC rules there will be no pre-Olympic competitions held in 1975. However the International Federations will be able to try out most of the installations, almost all of which are already known, at national and international events during the next seasons.

The bobsleigh federation has maintained the attribution of the 1975 world championships to Igls, while the Patscherkofel slope will be tried out in the winter of 1974.

A rack-railway 1½ miles long will be built for the other events planned on the Hoald. Able to transport 1200 people an hour, it will cost about 80 million schillings and will be finished in 1975.

The Olympic village will be built at "Arzl-Süd" near the 1964 village. It will com-

prise 532 flats, 468 of which will be three-roomed and 64 four-roomed, as well as an underground garage for 300 vehicles.

The village's restaurant and kitchens will be built in a future school.
