IOC Member for Italy since 1932, and promoted to honorary member in 1964, Count Paolo Thaon Di Revel has just died in his cherished town of Turin, of which he had been Mayor from 1929 to 1935.

Born in 1888 at Toulon, France, he was Olympic champion in team fencing at Anvers in 1920. A great sportsman and excellent administrator, he was a man who showed complete independence of spirit, above all towards governments.
