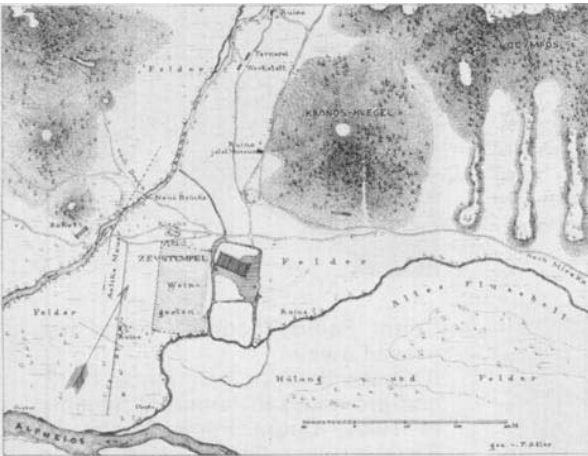


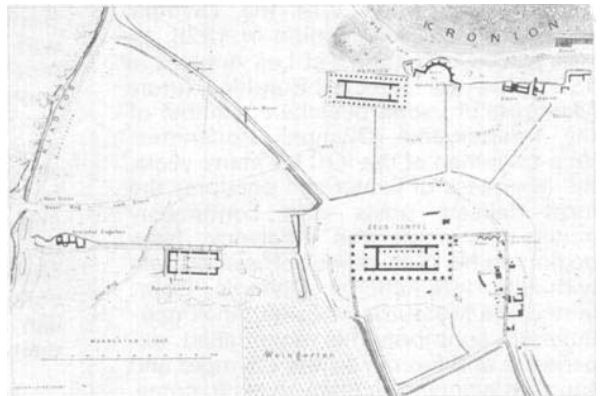
History (illustrated) of the excavations in Olympia

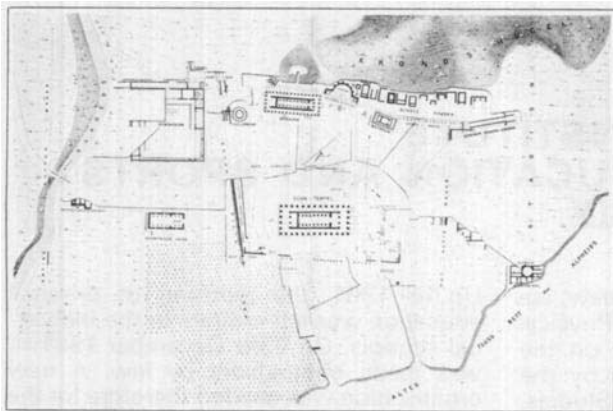

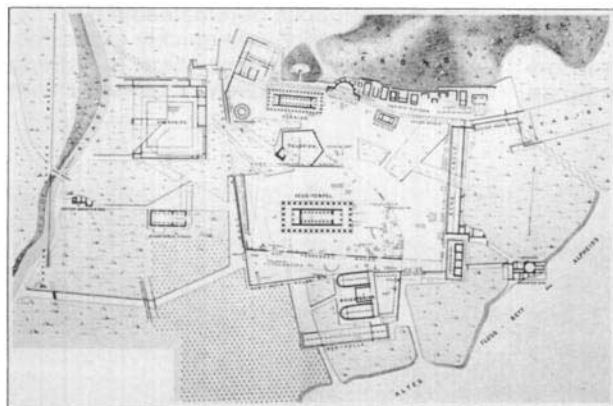
*Situation plan

1876)*



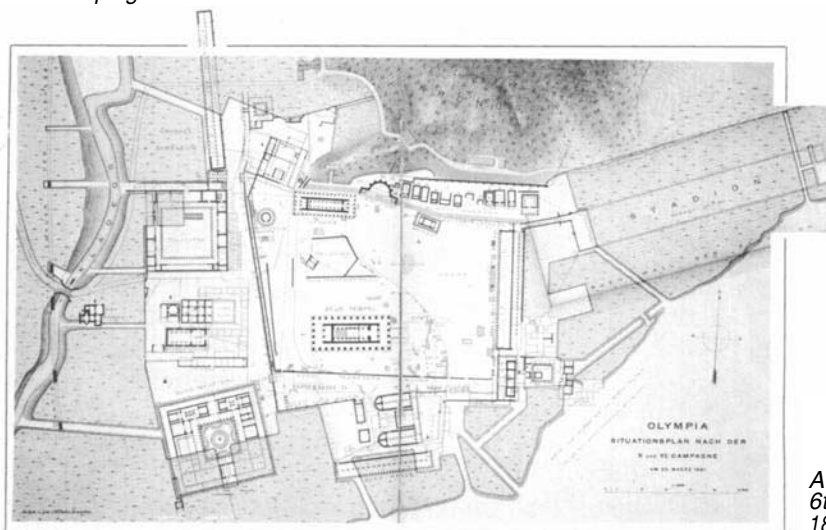
*Situation plan
