

## *In August, Moscow, Capital of University Sport*

On the occasion of the summer *Universiade* 1973 which will take place in Moscow from 15th-25th August 1973, the Organising Committee has edited special news bulletins in three languages, Russian, English and French. These very explicit bulletins are well illustrated and aim to make sport better known in USSR and bring all kinds of information to those who will participate, spectators, journalists and those who are not only interested in sport but the country where the *Universiade* 1973 will take place. We heartily recommend these bulletins to our readers.

– About 4500 people representing 22 nations will participate in the sports appearing on the programme<sup>1</sup>:

The organizer of the Committee, under the presidency of Vladimir Bogatikov seems to have provided the ideal conditions for a complete success at this meeting of students.

For Moscow, the only city at the present time to have offered its candidature for the organization of the Olympic Games of 1980, the organization of the *Universiade* will prove to be the most convincing argument in the presentation of its dossier.
