



## MONTREAL '76

### **The Organising Committee for the Games of the XXIst Olympiad received by the IOC Executive Board**

H. E. Roger Rousseau, President of the Organising Committee for the Games of the XXIst Olympiad in 1976 in Montreal, accompanied by Mr. James Worrall, IOC member for Canada, Mr. Gerry Snyder, Me. Marcel Desjardins and Me. Richard Gareau, met with the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee on 9th February 1974 and agreed on the following points:

1. A television programme has been set up by common agreement and any future negotiations will be carried out jointly.
2. A programme of self-financing has been proposed and approved. This consists of coins and stamps to be sold internationally, a lottery in Canada, and an international licensing programme.
3. Accommodation of the press is being studied to allow journalists to benefit from the best working conditions.
4. A Session of the Executive Board of the IOC will be held in late September 1975 in Montreal.
5. The 78th Session will be held from 10th-16th July 1976 in the Queen Elizabeth Hotel, Montreal where the IOC will be housed.

Moreover, the Executive Board has decided:

- to include in the CANOE-KAYAK programme for the Games in Montreal the four following events for men: kayak single (K1) 500 m, Canadian single (C1) 500 m, kayak pair (K2) 500 m, Canadian pair (C2) 500 m.

It should be pointed out that these events do not add to the number of competitors, juries, trainers, judges or competition officials.

- to limit the number of GYMNASTS who will take part in these Games as follows:
  - a) *Team event*: 12 teams for men, 12 teams for women, each composed of 6 gymnasts and one reserve.  
In addition, 4 groups of individual gymnasts for men and women, each group composed of 6 participants.
  - b) *Individual combined event*: Maximum of 3 entries per country for men and women who have been entered in the team event under a).
  - c) *Individual apparatus event*: Maximum of 2 entries per country for men and women who have been entered in the team event under a).
