World championships

February

8th and 9th: speed skating at Oslo (Norway); 8th to 22nd: bobsleigh at Cervinia (Italy); 9th to 16th: biathlon at Asiago (Italy); 10th to 16th: luge at Hammarstrand (Sweden); 15th and 16th: speed skating (sprint) at Gothenburg (Sweden); 22nd and 23rd: women's speed skating at Assen (Sweden).

March

4th to 8th: figure skating at Colorado Springs (United States).

April

3rd to 9th: ice hockey (group A) at Munich and Dusseldorf (FRG).

June

10th to 19th: yachting (Finn) in Spain; 23rd to 29th: archery at Interlaken (Switzerland).

July

7th to 13th: yachting (470) in the United States; 10th to 20th: fencing at Budapest (Hungary); 19th to 28th: swimming at Cali (Columbia); 31st to 3rd August: canoeing at Belgrade (Yugoslavia).

August

2nd to 10th: yachting (Soling) at Chicago (United States); 4th to 10th: yachting (F.D.) in the United States; 20th to 30th: rowing at Nottingham (Great Britain); 20th to 30th: cycling at Liège (Belgium); 20th to 31st: yachting (Tornado) at Copenhagen (Denmark); end August: women's basketball at Cali (Columbia).

September

10th to 21st: wrestling at Minsk (USSR); 11th to 19th: shooting (trap, skeet, running boar) at Munich (FRG); 15th to 24th: weightlifting at Moscow (USSR).

October

23rd to 26th: judo at Vienna (Austria).

December

3rd to 14th: women's handball in the USSR.
