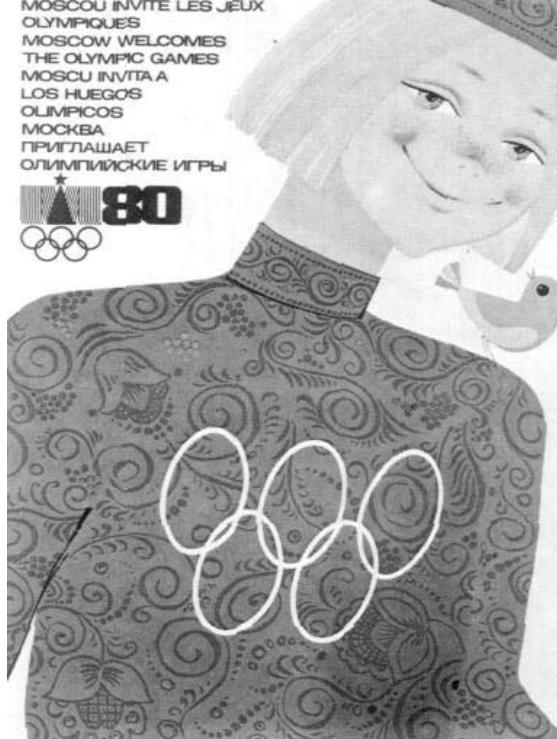

### The Organising Committee

One of the Soviet Union's important figures is to be President of the Organising Committee of the Games celebrating the XXIInd Olympiad. He is Mr. Ignati T. Novikov, 68, Vice-President of the USSR Cabinet, well-known for his engineering and administration career in the field of construction.

Among the members of the Committee, which was appointed at the beginning of March, we find Mr. Vladimir Promislov, President of the Moscow City Council, Mr. Sergei Pavlov, President of the USSR Physical Education and Sports Committee and the USSR NOC, Mr. V. Kotchenasov, Vice-President of the Cabinet of the Republic of Russia, Mr. A. Gren, Vice-President of the Republic of Esthonia, the two IOC members for the USSR, Mr. Constantin Andrianov, President of the USSR NOC from 1952 to 1975, Vice-President of the IOC from 1966 to 1970, and Mr. Vitaly Smirnov, member of the IOC Executive Board, and Messrs. Alekin, Bogatkov, Borisenkov, Chapochnikov, Dmitreev, Fomin, Gontsharov, Gramov, Jagodkin, Katrisch, Kovalev, Koval, Kondrashov, Koukarski, Lapin, Molokin, Nikitin, Possokin, Ondaltzov, Prohorov, Rakmanin, Rakovski, Riabova, Rogatin, Ragoulski, Safonov, Simonov, Sitchev, Sokolov, Stanislavov, Stchelokov, Stoukalin, Talizin, Tjarzelnikov, Valas, Zamjatin and Zemskov.
