

Olympic Honours

Before commencing their discussions on 2nd February, the IOC members assembled for the Session applauded and congratulated several recipients of the 1975 Olympic awards. That morning, in the Tyrol Hall of Innsbruck's Congress Centre, the President of the IOC, Lord Killanin, handed the Olympic Cup to the President of the Italian National Olympic Committee, Mr. Giulio Onesti, and introduced to the Olympic Order three of the first recipients chosen last year: Mrs. Ellen Muller Preis (Austria), Mrs. Lia Manoliu (Rumania) and Mr. Gyula Hegyi (Hungary), all holders of a bronze medal.
