**XVlth Session  
of the IOA**

As of now, all National Olympic Committees will be thinking about the registration of up to five participants in the annual Session of the International Olympic Academy. Those of our readers wishing to take part, who are less than thirty-five years old and have a good knowledge of French or English, should contact their country's National Olympic Committee without delay.

Held from 29th June to 15th July at Olympia, under the patronage of the International Olympic Committee and the auspices of the Hellenic Olympic Committee, this XVlth Session will examine, as its basic subject, *the international Olympic movement*, and, as a special subject, *the new generation and Olympism*. The success of the proceedings depends on the quality of the participants and their preparation. Each National Olympic Committee is therefore required to select candidates capable of taking an active part in the discussions and thus of obtaining a training as an *ambassador* of Olympism.

The official languages are English, French and Greek. Living expenses, which include accommodation, meals, travelling expenses in Greece as well as guided tours, amount to 250 dollars. The complete programme and list of lecturers will be published in a future issue.

On the next page, we start the publication of Pierre de Coubertin's *Mémoires Olympiques* in their entirety. Following chapters will appear in forthcoming numbers.

We should like to renew our thanks to Mr. Geoffroy de Navacelle, great-nephew of the renovator of the Olympic Games, for giving his consent to this republication. We remind our readers that some of his comments intended to help them understand this work appear on page 30 of our last issue.
