We have learned of the recent deaths of the following defenders of the Olympic and sports movement:

● **Anders Ahlgren** (SWE, 88 years of age), 1912 Olympic finalist in Greco-Roman wrestling, light heavyweight category. His opponent in the match was Ivar Boehling, the Finn. After a bout lasting five to six hours, they were both declared equal second and the gold medal was not awarded.

● **Wladimir Golebiewski** (POL, 62 years of age), Vice-President of the Fédération Internationale Amateur de Cyclisme and President of the Polish Cycling Federation, a journalist and member of

the management committee of "Trybuna-Luda", suffered a heart attack while attending a meeting of the Organising Committee of the Peace Race.

● **Pascual Perez** (ARG, 50 years of age), Olympic boxing champion in 1948, passed away on 22nd January in Buenos Aires.
