To the NOCs

Re: Press attachés at the Games of the XXIInd Olympiad and XIIIth Winter Games - 1980

. . . The 79th Session of the International Olympic Committee, meeting in Prague, modified Rule 49 of the IOC Olympic Rules. In accordance with this new rule and in order to facilitate the task of the Organising Committees' press officers, the National Olympic Committees are requested, if at all possible, to nominate a press attache or a member of their Committee who will be responsible for press relations in his country, the arrangement of interviews with athletes in its delegation and the distribution of special tickets.

This attaché must be included in the personnel attached to teams in accordance with Rule 40, until such time as the rule is changed to allow an extra official for this purpose.

I should therefore be grateful if you would let me know the name and address of the person you appoint for this function, for which I thank you...

Re : Olympic awards

... Every year the International Olympic Committee selects personalities to receive, according to their merit, the gold, silver or bronze medal of the Olympic Order, while an institution or association is awarded the Olympic Cup. The regulations concerning these awards appear on page 76 of the 1976 edition of the Olympic Rules.

I should be grateful if you would submit any recommendations concerning the 1978 award of the Olympic Order and/or Olympic Cup, for which a decision will be made at the 80th IOC Session in Athens, to the general secretariat of the International Olympic Committee by *1st March 1978* at the latest. In this respect please find forms enclosed which I would ask you to return duly completed...

2. Additions to the list of doping substances agreed at the meeting of the IOC Medical Commission - Lausanne, 7th and 8th May 1977 :

Include under (a) *Psychomotor stimulant drugs* :

— phentermine, chlorphentermine, meclufenoxate, pemoline, pipradol.

include under (b) *Sympathomimetic amines* :

— chlorprenaline, etafedrine, isoetharine, isoprenaline.

Include under (c) *Miscellaneous central nervous system stimulants* :

— doxapram, ethamivan, picrotoxin.

Include under (d) *Narcotic analgesics* :

— anileridine, codeine, dihydrocodeine, ethylmorphine, hydrocodone, hydromotphone, levorphanol, oxocodone, oxomorphone, pentazocine, phenazocine, piminodine, thebacon, trimeperidine.
