THE SPORTING YEAR, under the direction of John Rodda and Clifford Makins. Published by Collins. St. James's Place, London (GBR). 1977, 256 pages, in English. Price : £4.95.

This work is the first attempt to publish the best British sports articles appearing between September 1976 and September 1977. The greatest names in the British press are included and the field of sports activities covered extends from rugby to women's boxing.

John Rodda and Clifford Makins have not simply chosen the articles for their intrinsic qualities but also for the perfect reflection they give of the concepts and values defended by the journalists of London's Fleet Street, the main newspaper street.
