SPORT 78, by Hugo Steinegger. Published by Editions Habegger Verlag, Dendingen - Soleure (SUI). 1977, 276 pages, 140 photographs, in German. Price : 9.80 Swiss francs.

With the publication of "Sport 78", this popular series of handbooks on Swiss sport written by Hugo Steinegger, head of the Swiss Sports Association's press department, continues its successful formula. This work contains the main details about the 70-odd sports practised in Switzerland, the 1978 calendar, a review of the year 1977 and important addresses and records, all of which are illustrated by more than 140 recent photographs.

"El Grafico" has gathered together in this brochure illustrations of the best goals scored throughout the world since the beginning of the century. There are a thousand and one different ways of kicking a goal as the photographs so eloquently prove.



OLYMPIA VON ATHEN BIS MOSKAU (The Olympic Games from Athens to Moscow), by Klaus Ullrich. Published by Editions Sportverlag, Berlin (GDR). 1977, 152 pages, in German. Price : 12.80 GDR M.

Better known in the world of sports journalists under the name of Klaus Huhn, Klaus Ullrich has compiled a work of great interest and immense educational value. He naturally reviews all the Olympiad celebrations, inserting the views of famous spectators such as Mark Twain and Eric Maria Remarque. He does not however omit to give us his own opinion on certain problems as well as his suggestions for the future of the Olympic movement.

PRINCIPES DE LA LUTTE LIBRE POUR ENFANTS ET ADOLESCENTS (Principles of freestyle wrestling for children and adolescents), by Raïko Petrov. Published by Meditsina i Fis-koultoura Sofia (BUL). 1975, 180 pages, in French.

With a view to furthering the FILA's programme concern-

ing the development of wrestling in the world, this work deals with the particular problems raised at each stage of childhood and adolescence, as well as the fundamental aspects of the technique and tactics of wrestling.

Brochure outlining briefly the many international successes won by Israeli athletes in 1977 and the 10th Maccabiah Games.

HISTOIRE DE LA NATATION MONDIALE ET FRANÇAISE (History of swimming worldwide and in France?), by François Oppenheim. Published by Editions Chiron, 40, rue de Seine, 75006 Paris (FRA). 1977, 360 pages, in French. Price : 90 French francs.

Fragmentary history of swimming from its origins to the 1977 season, portrayed through statistics.

AM DAT MINA CU EI... (I have shaken them by the hand...), by Victor Banciulescu. Published by Editura Sport-Turism, Bucharest (ROM). 1977, 200 pages, in Romanian. Price : 5.75 Lei.

Victor Banciulescu presents his memories of meetings with champions of the past and present, of interviews, of friendly, ever valuable conversations. He goes back over their lives, their hopes and fears, and the place that sport has had—and still has—in their lives.
