



In Indonesia

● *Mr. Janusz Piewcewicz*, assistant Secretary General of the Polish Olympic Committee, recently visited Djakarta at the request of Olympic Solidarity. Placing his vast experience at the service of the KOI, he advised officials on preparations for the 10th South East Asian Games to take place from 21st to 30th September 1979. In his report he stated : "Eighteen disciplines make up the programme, 13 Olympic sports among them. One of the disciplines, sepak-takraw, is a very spectacular sport, quite similar to volleyball, the difference being that the ball may be struck with any part of the body except the hands. It gives me satisfaction to note that Indonesian participants in the Sessions of the IOA as well as those in Olympic Solidarity seminars are still concerned with the administration of sport. Sport thus profits from the international training they have acquired".

Mr. Sudono had participated in the Olympic Solidarity seminar organised in Sussex (GBR) in 1976. He assumes the duties of Assistant Secretary General of the KOI and of Secretary General of the national basketball federation. In addition, he is responsible for the successful completion of government-financed construction projects for sports facilities. He is also to be in charge of administrative questions for the SEA Games.

Mr. Sutardiono, who took part in the work of the same seminar, provides physical educa-

tion courses at the school of education and serves as Vice-President of the Indonesian Volleyball Federation. He is to be assistant head of the "sport" section at the SEA Games.

Mr. Amir Lubis, a participant in the 1977 IOA Session, is in charge of the "sports training" department of the National Sports Council and serves as Secretary of the Djakarta athletics federation.

Mr. Abdul Askar is to assume responsibility for the "sports" section of the SEA Games. In charge of athletics courses, he recently participated in the Olympic Solidarity seminar organised in Brighton (GBR).
