● **Mr. Pedro Ramirez Vazquez**, IOC member, Mexican Minister of Housine and Public Works and the architect of the-Mexican national anthropological museum, among the world's most beautiful, and of the Notre-Dame-de-la-

Guadeloupe basilica, has received the gold medal of the French Academy of Architecture at a ceremony held in the national galleries of the Grand Palais in Paris.

We have learned of the recent deaths of the following defenders of the Olympic and sports movement.

● **Gaston Heuet** (FRA, 86), an Olympic participant in 1912, 1920 and 1924. He was a member of the cross country team which placed third in 1924.

● **Howard Nicholson** (USA, 82), was the coach of the world famous figure skater Sonja Henie when she captured

three Olympic titles in 1928, 1932 and 1936 in addition to ten world championship crowns.

● **Zbigniew Turski** (POL, 71), a musician who earned an award at the 1948 Olympic art and music competitions for his Olympic symphony.
