● **Competition sites**

In Moscow: athletics, rowing, boxing, canoe-kayak, road cycling, equestrian, fencing, football, gymnastics, including rhythmic sports gymnastics, weightlifting, judo, wrestling, including sambo, swimming (diving and water-polo), modern pentathlon, shooting, archery, volleyball, chess.

In Kaunas : basketball.

In Kiev : handball.

In Leningrad : hockey.

In Lvov: track cycling.

In Minsk: football.

In Riga : tennis.

In Tallinn : yachting.

In Vilnius : basketball.

● **Basketball**

Men's teams from the United States of America, Olympic champion, Yugoslavia, world champion, Czechoslovakia and Senegal as well as women's teams from the United States of America, France, Poland and Czechoslovakia, have been invited to meet the best teams from the Soviet republics as well as those from Moscow and Leningrad.

● **Handball**

The world champion team (GER) and three other foreign squads (GDR, ROM, TUN) have been issued invitations to participate in the men's tournament. Four teams from abroad (DEN, GDR, NOR, YUG) are to take part in the women's tournament.

● **Athletes from 33 African NOCs** are to receive invitations.
