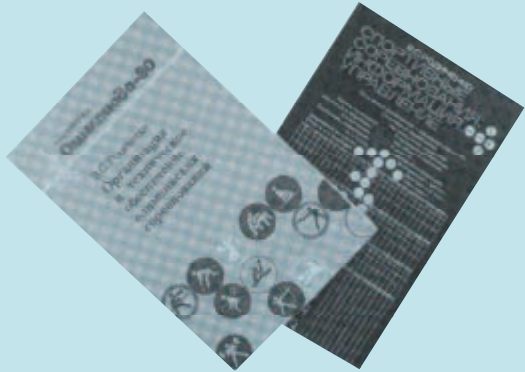
With photos, drawings, diagrams and explanatory texts, David Hunn goes to great lengths to enable his
