

## Olympism in mourning

*The "Olympic Review" has learned of the passing of the following defenders of the Olympic and sports movements.*

- **Sir Ludwig Guttmann**, President of the International Stoke-Mandeville Games Federation. Sir Ludwig was known as a tireless humanist vitally concerned with the welfare of the physically handicapped. An ardent proponent of sport as therapy



for the disabled, his unbridled optimism and unceasing attempts to assist spinal cord paraplegics both in medical and social terms earned him world renown in his field.

- **Urbain Cazaux** (FRA, 88), who served as President of the French skiing federation from 1948 to 1965 and as a member of the FIS Council from 1953 to 1967 at which time he became an honorary member of the Federation. Mr. Cazaux was also an officer in the Legion of Honour.
- **Ernest Muhlethaler** (SUI, 55), a member of the IHP Council and honorary member of the Swiss handball federation.
