THE ITV BOOK OF THE OLYMPICS. Published by Independent Television Books, 247 Tottenham Court Road London W1P 0AU (GBR), 1980. 144 pages, in English.

Intended primarily perhaps as an introduction to ITV's television coverage of the Games of the XXIInd Olympiad rather than as an authoritative work, this book presents an easily accessible and extensively illustrated history of the Olympic Games from 776 BC to 1980.

UNITED STATES OLYMPIC BOOK 1980. Published by the United States Olympic Committee, Colorado Springs (USA) in cooperation with Sport and Culture USA Inc./prosport, Salt Lake city (USA), 1980 272 pages, In English

This handsome volume traces the involvement of sports organisations and athletes from the United States in the 1980 Olympic year. Full results lists, feature articles and biographical notes on all United States team members complement the superlative quality of the photography which is a feature of the work.

THE JOURNAL OF SPORTS MEDICINE AND PHYSICAL FITNESS. (Official journal of the International Sports Medicine Federation - FIMS) Published by Edizioni Miner-va Medica Corso Bramante 83-85, 10126 Turin (ITA) In English with summaries in French and Spanish

This quarterly review is devoted to "the medical aspects of sport and physi-

cal training for the purpose of improving and maintaining health". Each edition features learned articles covering the psychological, physiological and pathological effects of muscular activity on the human body.



BIORAMA SKI 81 by Serge and Patrick Lang. Published by Biorama Ski A.G Rheintalweg 106, 4125 Riehen (SUI) 1981. 102 pages, available in French or German.

The 10th Edition of this popular ski annual which contains comprehensive statistical results and biographical sections as well as feature articles and a host of interviews and articles devoted to leading personalities from the world of skiing. For the first time this year a 78 page companion volume entitled BIORAMA SKI, classements mondiaux (world rankings) is available, from the same publishers.

THE ATHLETE IN THE SPORTS TEAM by Bryant J. Cratty and Yuri L. Hanin. Published by the Love Publishing Company, Denver, Colorado 80222 (USA). 1980. 231 pages, in English.

Written by two eminent researchers, one from the United States of America and one from the Soviet Union, this learned treatise is dedicated to "people in all countries who are trying to improve human relationships and understanding through sport". The work takes the form of a series of social-psychological guidelines intended to help coaches and athletes work together in greater harmony and understanding.

FOTOSPORT 80 by the "Ploms" Swimming Club, Reus. Ediciones Fills d'Antoni Fàbregas. S/A.. Reus (ESP). 1980.

The Reus Swimming Club, with the permission of the Spanish Olympic Committee and the International Olympic Committee, organised the "VIth International Salon of Sports Photography", which was held from 10th June to 10th July 1980. It was attended by approximately one thousand photographers from 35 countries. The catalogue includes many superb photographs which won prizes at the Salon.

ACADÉMIE D'ARMES N° 12 (Fencing Academy). Published by the French Fencing Academy, 13. rue de Londres, Paris (FRA), October 1980. 58 pages, in French

A special issue of the well-known fencing periodical with a section entirely devoted to a review of French participation in the fencing tournaments of each celebration of the Olympic Games from 1898 to 1980.
