Re: Meeting of the IOC Executive Board with the International Federations - April 1981.

The International Olympic Committee is currently studying a number of matters, some of which also concern the International Federations.

Therefore, I should be grateful if you would give your Federation's views on the following points at our next meeting in April :

1. Rule 26 (Eligibility Rule for the Olympic Games).
2. Proposal for a permanent site for the Games of the Olympiad.
3. Is an age limit for participants specified in the rules of your Federation ?...

The President of the IOC would also be grateful if you would consider the questions you would like to ask, either after your visit to Los Angeles, or in anticipation of your forthcoming visit...

Re : Participation of coaches in the Olympic Congress.

...Following a recommendation made by the Working Group of the Tripartite Commission, this Commission has decided to invite ten coaches to take part in the Olympic Congress. One of these will subsequently be elected to speak.

Nominations are therefore requested from the International Federations for suitable candidates, which are to be confirmed by the relevant NOC if chosen. The criteria for nomination are the following :

1. To be citizens of, and resident in, the country in which they work.

2. To have coached winners of medals in either the 1976 or the 1980 Games.
3. Not to be the coaches of athletes who have been nominated for participation in the Congress.
4. No more than one coach per NOC to be invited.

Nominations from the IFs are requested by 1st March 1981 at the latest, in order that they may be studied at the next meeting of the Tripartite Commission Working Group. The final decision will be the sole prerogative of the Tripartite Commission...

Re: Participation of athletes at the XIth Olympic Congress

... At the meeting of the Tripartite Commission of the IOC held on 23rd January in Baden-Baden, the subject of the participation of athletes was raised, after prior discussion by the Working Group.

Following a recommendation from this Group, it was decided that, due to an insufficient response from both International Federations and National Olympic Committees, the period in which nominations may be submitted would be extended.

Furthermore, the age limit for athletes has been definitively set as being born no earlier than 1st January 1951.

If your organisation has eligible athletes and wishes to put forward nominations, you are requested to do so before 1st March 1981 in order that these may be studied by the Working Group at their meeting on 16-17th March in Moscow. The Working Group has been empowered by the Tripartite Commission to make the final selection of athletes, and you will be informed of their decision in due course following the meeting.
