



For the first time an Olympic Week has been organised in Lausanne from 22nd to 25th February 1982, on the initiative of the International Olympic Committee and under the patronage of the Municipality. Its aim was to promote the Olympic idea and the principles of the Olympic movement on a broader basis. The programme was as follows:

*Monday 22nd February*

19 h. 30 Preview of poster exhibition.

20 h. 00 Speech by Mr. Juan Antonio Samaranch, President of the IOC.

Presentation of the Olympic Order to Mr. Jean-Pascal Delamuraz, national councillor.

Speech by Mr. Paul-René Martin, Mayor of the town of Lausanne.

Lecture given by Mr. Mohamed Mzali, Prime Minister of the government of the Republic of Tunisia, IOC member: "The Olympic Philosophy".

*Tuesday 23rd February*

20 h. 00 Lecture given by Mr. Nikolaos Nissiotis, IOC member for Greece, President of the International Olympic Academy :

"The International Olympic Academy and the Influence of Olympism.

"The Gods of the Stadium", film by Leni Riefenstahl.

*Wednesday 24th February*

20 h. 00 Lecture given by Mr. Raymond Gafner, IOC member for Switzerland, President of the Swiss Olympic Committee :

"The Future of the Olympic Athlete".

"The Games of the Modern Era" and film by Daniel Costelle.

*Thursday 25th February*

20 h. 00 Lecture given by Mr. Marc Hodler, IOC member for Switzerland, President of the International Ski Federation:

"The Winter Games"

"Chariots of Fire", film by Hugh Davidson & David Puttnam.
