The aim of this 38th Festival is to spread, through the medium of the cinema, the Olympic Ideal as well as information and propaganda in the field of sport. A jury appointed by the Organising Committee will award the three "City of Turin" prizes to the three best films. It will also be called on to award the following prizes : the CONI Prize for a "First Film", the AGIS Prize for "Sport and Entertainment", the Region of Piedmont Prize for "Sport and Tourism", the Province of Turin Prize for "Sport and Culture" and the "Junior First Film" Prize.

Applications to take part are to be sent to the "Organising Committee", Via di Villa Patrizi 10 - 00161 Rome (ITA). Entries, which are to be sent to the same address by 31 st March 1982, may be in black and white or in colour, and 35 mm or 16 mm. Whether short or long, they must naturally all have sport as their main subject.

The "Junior First Film" Prize is intended to encourage, develop and aid budding young producers of talent. It will be awarded to three youngsters or groups of youngsters between the ages of 6 and 10, 10 and 14, and 14 and 18, each category receiving a prize of 2500,000 lira. In addition, a scholarship worth 5,000,000 lira will be awarded to a young scriptwriter under the age of 18 to enable him to produce his story, which of course, once again, will have to deal with sport.

Films in this category may be 8 mm, super 8 or 16 mm. They must not exceed 45 minutes in length, and may be silent or with sound, in black and white or in colour. Applications to take part must reach the Secretariat of the 38th international Sports Film Festival - Via di Villa Patrizi 10-00161 Rome (ITA) by 28th February 1982.
