- Games of the XXIIIrd Olympiad

Please find enclosed a form including the number of technical officials requested by your International Federation for the Olympic Games in 1984.

I should be most grateful if you would kindly confirm that these figures are correct by returning this form to me and ask you for a detailed description of these officials (jurys, referees, judges, timekeepers, medical personnel if any, etc.).

In addition, I should very much appreciate your indicating whether technical delegates are included or not in the figures.

Furthermore, in accordance with the decision taken at the last meeting between the IOC Executive Board and the representatives of the Summer IFs in Los Angeles, may I request you to reconsider and study the possibility of reducing as much as possible the total number of foreign officials required by your Federation, taking into account the high costs involved and the limited sources available.

May I add that your comments must be received by *1st April at the latest* in order to be submitted for the final approval of the next IOC Session in Rome, during May...

Re : 89th Session - 1985

. . . As you are aware, the 89th Session of the International Olympic Committee is due to be held in 1985, the venue for which will be decided at the next Session in May in Rome.

The IOC has already received formal invitations from the Comité Olympique Egyptien and the Nationales Olympisches Komitee der Deutschen Demokratischen Republik offering to hold the Session in Cairo and Berlin respectively.

However, should your National Olympic Committee wish to organise this Session, we should be grateful to receive your application by *30th April 1982* at the latest.
