- The International Association Against Violence in Sport (AICVS), in association with the AIPS, has created a new award for writers and journalists who contribute to the fight against violence in sport. International Advisory Body for Physical Education and Sport

- At the time of the European Athletics Championships which were held in Athens from 6th to 12th September last, Mr. August Kirsh, the new President of the "*Conseil International pour l'education physique et le sport*" (International Advisory Body for Physical Education and Sport) had a meeting with Juan Antonio Samaranch, President of the IOC to discuss the new trends in collaboration between the IOC and the CIEPS.

Elected for a 6 year term of office, Mr. Kirsch, who is also Vice President of the "Nationales Olympisches Komitee für Deutschland", replaces Sir Roger Bannister and will officially take up office in January 1983. The administrative offices of the CIEPS will be transferred from London to the Federal Institute of Cologne (FRG).
