Sports data bank

On 2nd February 1983, at Lausanne. the International Olympic Committee represented by H.E. Mr Juan Antonio Samaranch, President, and Mrs. Monique Berlioux, Director. and the sports newspaper "L'Equipe". represented by General Laure and Messrs. Edouard Seidler and Robert Pariente, decided to collaborate on the setting up of a sports data bank encompassing many disciplines and covering sports of the past. present and future. and related subjects.

To this end, specialised committees have been set up by the IOC and "L'Equipe", whose tasks will be to define the general concept of the data bank and to carry out the technical and financial analysis
