



*Mr. Rosandich and the IOC President.*

On the 8th of December, the IOC President was honoured with the "Distinguished Service Award" of the United States of America Sports Academy, which he received at the Chateau de Vidy, from the hands of Mr. Thomas P. Rosandich, the President of that Academy.

It was once again at Vidy that the President, together with Madame Berlioux, IOC Director, welcomed Mr. Willi Weyer, President of the German Sports Confederation (DSB), and Mr. Karlheinz Gieseler, Secretary General of that institution. The discussions dealt essentially with the matter of sport for all and the prospects for co-operation in this field between the IOC, the DSB and other international organisations. This exchange of views, which was followed by a luncheon attended by Mr. Raymond Gafner, IOC member and President of the Swiss NOC, took place in an atmosphere of mutual sympathy. At Mr. Weyer's invitation, H.E. Mr. Juan Antonio Samaranch will deliver an address on the subject of fair play during the National Congress meeting of that organisation some time during 1984.

### **In Lausanne**
