

Specialist journalists/Games of the XXIIIrd Olympiad Los Angeles (1.12.1983)

During its meeting held on 28th November 1983 in Lausanne, the IOC Press sub-commission considered the distribution of a total quota of 150 for the specialised press at the Games of the XXIIIrd Olympiad in Los Angeles.

It has been decided to allocate your NOC a total of: accreditations.

The Los Angeles Organising Committee has been informed of this decision and will send you shortly the necessary forms.

Would you please distribute these to the journalists concerned and return them, duly completed, to the OCOG.

The agreement reached between the IOC and the LAOOC on specialised press concerns only nine sports : archery, canoeing, equestrian sports, fencing, hockey, modern pentathlon, shooting, rowing and yachting.

It is your responsibility to distribute the quota allocated to you between these nine sports in the best way possible to satisfy the requests you have received. Kindly send us, for each sport, the names of the journalists and magazines who will receive these accreditations.

Finally, kindly point out to the journalists concerned that these are partial accreditations which give access only to the competition site of the sport concerned and the press sub-centre for this site. The specialised journalists will not have access to the main press centre, the Olympic Villages or the other competition sites.

In accordance with the terms of the agreement, the LAOOC will not be responsible for the housing and transport of holders of these accreditations.

Athletes' clothing during the Olympic Games (12.12.83)

At the recent Executive Board meeting in Lausanne the question of athletes' clothing during the Olympic Games was discussed.

It was decided that all athletes should wear the uniform of their particular National Olympic Committee.

Press Delegate/Games of the XXIIIrd Olympiad in Los Angeles (2.12.83)

During one of its last meetings, the IOC Press Commission decided that the same procedure adhered to in Moscow and Lake Placid for the distribution of press tickets, should be followed also for the Games of the XXIIIrd Olympiad in Los Angeles.

Thus, the Press Commission, through its sub-commission, will assure the distribution of the special press tickets necessary for certain events and certain sports.

In order to facilitate its work, please let us know the name of the person who will be responsible, from within your delegation, for relations with the sub-commission.

IF assistance in dope control stations (2.12.83)

It is essential that the representative of your International Federation which you were asked to nominate to assist the IOC Medical Commission with the operations in the dope control station on the site of your competitions in Sarajevo or Los Angeles, be someone who is a/ready accredited by your IF. There is unfortunately no possibility of extra accreditations for this purpose.

In addition, it is pointed out that this representative cannot in any case be a team doctor.
