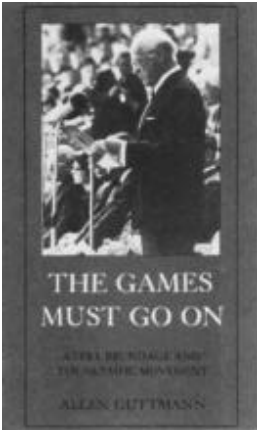

Leading expert on the history of sports. Allen Guttman offers a unique view of the deepest and most fundamental values of a man entirely dedicated to the Olympic Games. Avery Brundage, athlete, businessman, art collector and manager, was IOC President for twenty years and widened the Olympic Movement to include the Communist block and the Third World, also insisting that the Games go on even in the face of the Munich tragedy.

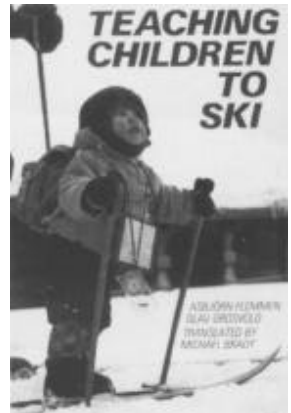
This practical handbook presents sports psychology - a scientific branch in its own right - its history, goals and various roles.

ing gold medals in Lake Placid in 1980), thoroughly covers all aspects of the innovative training methods which enabled her, by means of her Olympic medals in 1972, to enter the United States in the speed-skating record book.

Illustrated with magnificent family photographs from his own private collection, this autobiography of H.R.H. Prince Bertil of Sweden, currently the President of his country's NOC, places particular emphasis on the monarch's keen interest in sport (athletics, speed-skating...) and in open-air activities, and his contribution to the Olympic Movement.
