Thoughts about violence in Monaco.

The second symposium on violence took place in Monaco on the 18th January 1984, in the presence of His Majesty Prince Albert of Monaco, who was representing His Royal Highness Prince Rainier, Honorary President of the AICVS ("Association Internationale Contre la Violence dans le Sport" - International Association Against Violence in Sport) and under the chairmanship of H.E. Mr. Juan Antonio Samaranch.

One of its objects being to define the situation of what had to be done against violence in sport, this conference was also to study the effects of the actual recommendations put to the public authorities the year before, and to consider new proposals.

A profitable dialogue took place between the three main associations involved (the AICVS, the Committee for Fair Play, and the De Backer Foundation) and the numerous sports federations representatives attending the meeting.
