YEARLY SPORTS REVIEW 5, ("Urhellun vuosikirja"), by Markku Siukonen and Matte Ahola, Scandia Kirjat, Jyväskylä, (FIN). 1983. 352 pages, in Finnish.



In addition to a chapter on the best Finnish athletes, an important part of the fifth edition of this world sport yearly review gives a description and the results of the first World Athletics Championships in Helsinki.

MODERN PENTATHLON, ("Pentathlon modern"), by Ioan Muresanu, Sport-Tunsm Publishers, Bucharest. (ROM) 395 pages. in Romanian

A regular modern pentathlon textbook, this publication not only gives the history and past international results of this Olympic discipline but also all the details of the organisation, rules and techniques of its five different events : riding, fencing, swimming, shooting and running.

HEALTH RISK ESTIMATION, RISK REDUCTION AND HEALTH PROMOTION, edited by Fernand Landry, Ph D., published by the

Canadian Public Health Association. Ottawa, (CAN). 1983. 691 pages, in English and French

Mr. Fernand Landry, who has often contributed articles for the "Olympic Review" and the "Olympic Message" has undertaken the task of compiling and editing the papers presented at the 18th Annual Meeting of the Society of Prospective Medicine in Quebec City, from 20th to 23rd October 1982. Among the most important subjects discussed in both English and French were those of the influence on health of the physical, psychological and social environments and the possibilities of preventive measure programmes.

BIORAMA SKI 84, THE WONDERFUL HISTORY OF THE OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES (« L'extraordinaire histoire des Jeux Olympiques d'hiver »), **WORLD RANKINGS** (« Classements mondiaux »), by Serge and Patrick Lang, Elorama SA Sports Publications, Rheintalweg 106. CH-4125 Rehem (SUI). 1984 respectively 105 65, and 97 pages, in French Price respectively SFR 8 -, 6 - and 8.—.

In honour of the Olympic year 1984, the two Swiss journalists Serge and Patrick Lang have published, in addition to their traditional yearly Biorama Ski, a "Biorama Sarajevo Special" which not only introduces the Games in Sarajevo but also gives the history of the Winter Games, and the "World Rankings" which give the facts and figures relevant to the Alpine and Nordic skiing World Cups, last season's results, and data concerning the five thousand current FIS competitors.

FRONTIERS OF EXERCISE BIOLOGY, Big Ten Body of Knowledge Symposium Series, Volume 13. edited by Borer. Edington, White, published by Human Kinetics Inc. Champaign. Illinois 61820 us \$54.00

The study of exercise biology at the cellular level is less than twenty five years old, but interest in this area continues to grow, and the frontier of knowledge in this field is receding thanks to the use of sophisticated analytical techniques. This book is the report of the thirteenth colloquy organised by the *Big Ten Body of Knowledge Symposium* at the University of Michigan (USA).

Jean-Pierre de Mondenard, a doctor in sports medicine and a keen cyclist, deals with the relationship existing between a more or less intensive involvement with cycling and a certain number of health problems, in the form of "questions-answers". For the greatest benefit of all standards of cyclists, he answers questions on nutrition and drugs, cycling for children, or about some of the sport's effects on the heart, the prostate, the feet...

The 12th Issue of the official Swiss sports handbook published by the Swiss Sports Association is a paperback illustrated with more than 180 photographs which provides a summary of the sporting events of 1983, the medals and records statistics, the addresses of all the Swiss and international sports federations, and the 1984 calendar of events for over seventy SDOrs.

This report of the work accomplished in Brazil by a large number German specialists in the fields of sports education, sociology, psychology and medicine, is the first book to ever describe the full implications of a political sports assistance scheme in a foreign country.

Published in Hebrew two years ago and now in English, this volume describes the history of the Maccabiah Games from their origins. With his book, Chaim Wein, holder of the bronze medal of the Olympic Order, Vice-President of the Olympic Committee of Israel and first Vice-President of the Maccabi World Union, has made an important contribution to the study of the history of Jewish sports and of the progress of sport in Israel.
