



LOS ANGELES '84, by Ken Kishimoto, published by Photo Japon, 1984. 208 pages in Japanese.

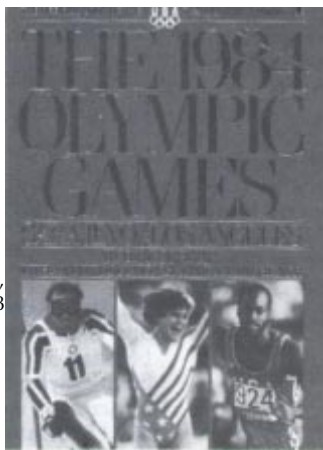
Full of photographs of the 1984 Olympic Games, this official report of the Japanese Olympic Committee is vivid, colorful and exciting even for those who do not read Japanese. A special section contains a brief history of Japan in the Olympic Games, the members of the 1984 team and results of the competitions in Los Angeles.

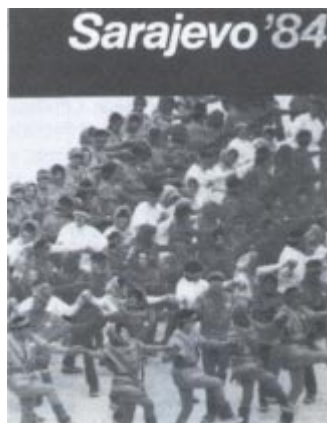

him by H.E. Mr. Juan Antonio Samaranch, President of the IOC. The book invites its readers to "build a culture of love, a civilisation of love".

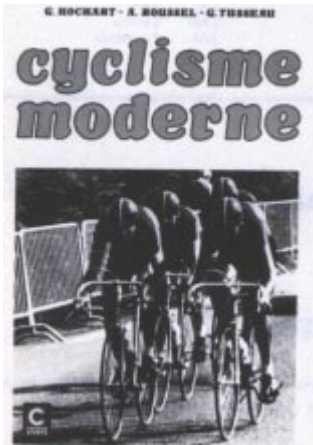

With a preface by Bruno Cornillet, who became a professional in 1984, and numerous illustrations, this work describes the experience of the authors - in charge of the French junior cycling team - and also presents some Scandinavian and Soviet scientific studies on cycling. The book thus outlines a method of preparing for competitive cycling for those racers who wish to obtain high-level results.
