THE LORD KILLANIN ARCHIVES

The archives entrusted to the IOC by the Lord Killanin, Honorary Life President of the IOC, have arrived at the Committee's headquarters, where President Samaranch in the company of Mrs. Monique Berlioux, Director, officially took possession of them in the name of the Olympic Movement.

This gift, five cubic meters in volume, is made up of all the correspondence and documents exchanged and prepared under the Lord Killanin's Presidency, from 1972 until 1980.

The archives constitute an important addition to the collections of the Baron de Coubertin, restorer of the Olympic Games, and the four other IOC Presidents, already in the care of the Olympic Museum.

The fifteen boxes were sealed on arrival, in accordance with the wish expressed by the Lord Killanin that their contents should not be made public until after his death.
