

Winter Games, which, in 1984, was still organised on a provisional basis, and which has since been given its final form (see next page).

The celebration of this first anniversary was also an occasion for honouring the memory of a great friend of Olympism, Lord Philip Noel-Baker, winner of the Nobel peace prize, who died in 1982.

The think-tank for the improvement of East-West and North-South dialogues, the creation of which, at the Inter-University Centre in Dubrovnik (YUG) in 1982, owed much to Lord Philip Noel-Baker, for the first time awarded its prize, dedicated to the memory of a great Statesman. This distinction is awarded to a person or organisation in recognition of distinguished services to peace and international understanding through sport.

The IOC President, H.E. Mr. Juan Antonio Samaranch, was chosen to be the first recipient of this prize.

The Organising Committee of the XIVth Winter Games received the prize awarded to organisations.

In Zagreb, where he ended his stay in Yugoslavia, the President met the members of the Organising Committee of the University Games in 1987, including its President, Mr. Josip Vrhovec, member of the Presidency of the SFR of Yugoslavia. Mr. Boris Bakrac, IOC member and Secretary General of that committee, showed him the sites of the future University Games and the technical organisation plans. The experience gained from the Olympic Winter Games will be very useful in the organisation of the University Games, especially as regards television broadcasting, which will be provided by the same teams as in Sarajevo in 1984, and the computerised results system.

A NEW ACADEMY

The honorary presidency of the newly created Yugoslavian Olympic Academy having been accepted by H.E. Mr. Juan Antonio Samaranch, the officials of the Olympic Committee decided to take advantage of his presence to hold the official inauguration ceremony.

The statutes of this national academy have not yet been established, but its aims were clearly defined by Mr. Zdravko Mutin on this occasion. The first session will be organised in 1986, on the magnificent site of the Winter Games.
