



### **THE FUTURE OF SPORT, THEME OF THE 12th OLYMPIC CONGRESS**

**P**reparations for the 12th Olympic Congress, which is to take place in Tokyo (JPN) in 1990, have officially begun. The commission specially appointed at the 90th Session in Berlin met for the first time on 16 December.

This commission, chaired by H.E. Mr. Juan Antonio Samaranch, consists of the three Vice-Presidents, Messrs. Alexandru Siperco, Ashwini Kumar and Berthold Beitz, Mr. Raymond Gafer, Administrateur délégué and Mrs. Françoise Zweifel, Secretary General, for the IOC, Messrs. Primo Nebiolo, Marc Hodler and Borislav Stankovic for the International Federations, and Messrs. Mario Vazquez Rana, Marian Renke and Col. Raoul Mollet for the National Olympic Committees. The Japanese Olympic Committee, which is hosting this important rendez vous for the Olympic family, has for its part appointed Messrs: Chiharu Igaya, member of the IOC, Shun-Ichiro Okano, its Secretary General, and one of its members, Mr. Masayuki Sano.

Having chosen the future of world sport as the main theme for this great assembly of the principal personalities and institutions involved in sport as an institution, this tripartite commission will, in the course of the next few meetings, have to draw up a more detailed programme and select the authorities to be invited.
