

## **AN OLYMPIC CENTRE IN CALGARY**

A \$5 million public information centre located in downtown Calgary is scheduled to open in January, 1986. The world-class Olympic information centre was designed, constructed and donated by a group of commercial, industrial and service companies.

Staffed by approximately a hundred and fifty volunteers, this facility will be a central meeting place for the public to learn more about all aspects of the XVth Olympic Winter Games. Facilities include three theatres, a central reception area, office space, meeting rooms and state-of-the-art audio visual and computer displays.
