

INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE OF SPORTS FOR THE DEAF

The International Committee of Sports for the Deaf (CISS) has compiled a handbook covering the past ten years since 1975. It contains a wealth of information, both current and historical, on records, the World Games (summer and winter) for the Deaf, members and honorees. The statutes and regulations are also included as is a list of technical delegates.

ICSSPE FIRST AWARDS OF THE PHILIP NOEL BAKER PRIZE FOR RESEARCH

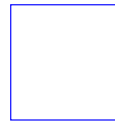
The award which bears the name of a great friend of Olympism, winner of the Nobel prize for peace and first president of the ICSSPE, was created last year to honour the meritorious work of personalities whose academic work and services rendered in the cause of sport are worthy of praise. The first award winners are Laszlo Kutassi (HUN) and Josef Recla (AUT).

Mr. Kutassi is singled out for his numerous scientific contributions in the field of sports history and for his active commitment in the work of the international committee for sports history and physical education (ICOSH). Mr. Recla is a

pioneer in the development of information and documentation in the field of sport. He is one of the founders of the International Bureau for Documentation and Information (IBDI), forerunner of the present International Association for Sports Information (IASI).

General Assembly

The 12th General Assembly and the 41st meeting of the executive committee of the ICSSPE will take place in Gdansk (POL) from 11 to 13 April 1986. These meetings will be preceded by an important international conference on the science of sport.

The XXIIIrd World Congress of Sports Medicine, organised by the International Sports Medicine Federation (FIMS) will be held in Brisbane (AUS) on 20th to 28th September 1986.
