Mr. Mohamed Mzali, Prime Minister of Tunisia and IOC member, was recently presented with the gold medal of the Arab Sports Union by the organization's president Prince Faisal Fahd Abdul Aziz (SAU), who is also a member of the IOC. The honour was bestowed upon Mr. Mzali in recognition of the service he has rendered to the Olympic Movement in Arab countries.

In expressing his thanks, he told those present in Tunis for the occasion that *"one of the principal qualities of sports which the youth of today are urged to avail themselves of is the sense of being a "winner" which must be a substitute for hopelessness, giving up and fatalism"*. To propagate this and other values inherent in the practice of sport, such as fair play, he called upon Arab governments to apply all possible material and moral means.
