FIRS

Following elections held during the FIRS Congress last summer in Adelaide (AUS), the composition of the Executive Board is now as follows: *PT*: Mr. Budd Van Roekel (USA), re-elected; *1st VPT*: Dr. Luis Alfonso Muñoz (COL); *2nd VPT*: Mr. Yoshiro Noguchi (LPN); *3rd VPT*: Mr. Isidro Oliveras Marques (ESP); *SG*: Mr. George Pickard (USA), re-elected; *Mr*: Mr. Jose A. B. d'Assa Castel-Branco (POR, Rink Hockey), Dr. Giuseppe Matranga (ITA, Racing) and Mr. James Pollard (USA, Figure Skating).

The Congress also voted to admit San Marino and Indonesia as new official members of the FIRS.



WTF

Like many other International Federations, the WTF also gained several new members in the past year. The national taekwondo federations of Bhutan, Zaire and Barbados were admitted by the Executive Council at its meeting in Colorado Springs (USA) in July 1986.

The seventeen-man WTF Taekwondo Demonstration Team, which toured Asia in March of last year, travelled to Africa in December making stops in Cairo (EGY), Kampala (UGA), Lagos (NGR), Accra (CHA) and Libreville (GAB) where they conducted training seminars, played matches with local athletes and gave demonstrations.
