



THE 1987 DIRECTORY IS OUT

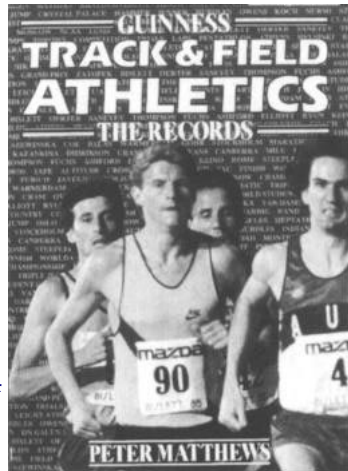
The Olympic Movement's indispensable vademecum has just been published. It is available as every year, from the IOC headquarters (Olympic House), for the price of 15. — SF.

MAI MULT DECIT O VICTORIE (Better than a victory) by Victor Bănculescu, edited by Editura Albatros, Bucharest (ROM), 1986. 147 pages in Romanian.

This latest work of the Romanian sports journalists Victor Bănculescu is devoted to the theme of fair play, a theme of great importance for the international Olympic and sports movement.

TRACK AND FIELD ATHLETICS: THE RECORDS by Peter Matthews, published by Guinness Books, 33 London Road, Enfield, Middlesex EN2 6DJ (GBR), 1986. 176 pages in English. Price: £7.95.

This is a work of reference illustrated by over 100 photographs. The reader will find in it the most salient events in the history of track and field, the progression of records by event and syntheses of major competitions such as the Olympic and Commonwealth Games. He will also find many of the great figures of world athletics such as Jesse Owens, Carl Lewis, Sergei Bubka, Edwin Moses and Marita Koch.

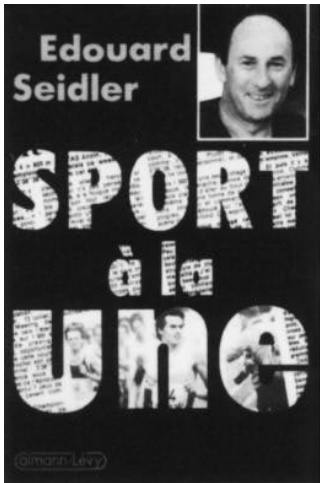

answers to parents' and coaches' questions and offer doctors a very complete guide to children's health. Bibliographic references following each chapter provide a useful guide to further study.

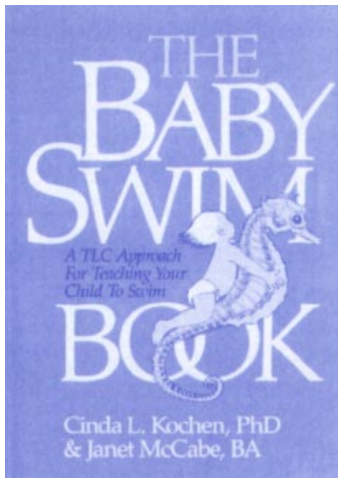

This book gives us an historical glimpse of the struggles of women athletes to break down sexual barriers and physiological myths, and provides an in-depth look at the latest research on endurance sport

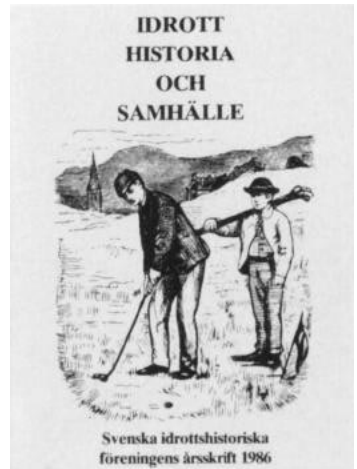
as practised by women. The various authors of this work describe the physiological, biomechanical and nutritional aspects of women's endurance sport.

This annual publication will enable the reader to explore "the memories of Swedish sport", recaptured thanks to contributions from numerous Swedish champions and medallists, and to discover the particular theme of this issue, which is "religion and sport in Sweden at the beginning of the 20th century". It also contains reports on two conferences organised by the IOC in Lausanne: the "International Meeting of Sports Museum Directors" and the international seminar on "the relevance of Pierre de Coubertin Today".
