



present in Vidy for the meeting with the IOC President and Mrs. Françoise Zweifel, which took place on 16th January 1987. The discussions referred to the possibilities of cooperation between the two bodies within the framework of the AIPS. Also raised was the issue of media coverage of the Games : those of 1988 and those of 1992, to be held in Europe, and the matter of the AIPS Congress to be held next year in Seoul,

It was to discuss the health and safety of athletes that Professor Wildor Hollman, President of the Federation Internationale de la Médecine Sportive (FIMS) came to Vidy to meet President Samaranch and Prince Alexandre de Merode, IOC Vice-President and Chairman of the IOC Medical Commission.

The interests of the two organisations obviously converge naturally towards progress in health protection for athletes. The concern aroused by drugs, doping, overtraining and poor nutrition is one they both share, and that is why greater cooperation in future should contribute towards the undertaking of in-depth studies in these various areas.

Within the framework of the Memorandum of Cooperation signed two years ago by the IOC and UNESCO, a working meeting was held on 14th January 1987.
