### **PRINCE ALBERT, HONORARY PRESIDENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL ATHLETICS FOUNDATION**

**G**rand gala evening on 12th December in Monaco to mark the launching of the International Athletics Foundation.

Prince Albert, who is Honorary President of the Foundation, was host to a number of distinguished personalities in world athletics. The purpose of the Foundation is to further aid and promotion for athletics worldwide. It will reward all the world-record breakers of 1986: Bubka (pole vault), Beyer (shotput), Shult (discus), Tafelmeier (javelin), Sedykh (hammer) among the men and Drechsler (200 m and long jump), Donkova (100 m hurdles), Kristlansen (10 000 m), Stepanova (400 m hurdles), Kostadinova (high jump), Whitbread (javelin), Joyner (heptathlon) among the women.

IAAF President, Mr. Primo Nebiolo explained that the moral aim of such an institution is to help clean up high-level sport. To this end, the Foundation has already planned its first seminar on doping, which will bring to Florence (ITA) the most eminent specialists on 10th and 12th May 1987.
