Mr. Ock-Jin Kim, who has just taken up his post as Secretary General, with the rank of Vice-President. He has four assistants :

Messrs. Yhe-Sup Choi, in administration ; Ju-Ho Chang, in sports operations ; Sang-Jin Chyun, in international relations and Kang-Pyung Lee, in policy research.

**M**r. Ock-Jin Kim took up his post as Vice-President and Secretary General of SLOOC at the beginning of December, replacing Mr. Lee Ha-Woo, who had resigned. Born in 1929 at Chinju, a town situated on the south coast of the Korean peninsula, Mr. Kim has a master's degree in political science from Yonsei University in Seoul. After finishing his studies, he began a career in public service which was to lead to the National Assembly, where he was First Secretary to the President and then responsible for Inter-parliamentary Affairs between 1963 and 1972. In this position, he played an important role in promoting foreign affairs for the Korean National Assembly.

He was a professor at Myungji University in Seoul for two years and from 1981 he took up the post of Presidential Secretary for political affairs, and then that of Secretary General of the Advisory Council on State Affairs until 1984, when he was appointed Vice Minister of Government Administration. Fluent in English and Japanese, Mr. Kim has travelled widely in Asia, the United States and Europe.

He will be particularly involved in the use of human resources, logistics, installations and security.
