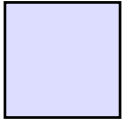

The Bowling World Cup, the most important annual amateur tournament in the bowling world, was held in Kuala Lumpur (MAL) from 8th to 15th November. This was the 23rd edition and it drew participants from thirty-seven countries in the men's division, and from thirty-three in the women's, with Chinese bowlers taking part for the first time in international competition.
