

## THE IOC IN MOURNING: SAD LOSS OF CONSTANTIN ANDRIANOV AND ANTONIN HIML

**Constantin Andrianov**, 77, died on 18th January. Elected to the IOC in 1951, he assumed its vice-presidency from 1966 to 1970. For thirty-seven years, the development of the Olympic movement in the USSR was his prime concern. **Antonin Himl**, 55 passed away on 27th January. President of the Czechoslovak NOC since 1972, he became the champion of Sport for All, a movement he believed valuable for humanity and was an influential Vice-President of the IOC Sport For All Commission. We will return in our net edition to the lives of these great figures in the world of sport. The IOC sends its deepest sympathy to the families of both the deceased and to the Soviet and Czechoslovak sports movements.
