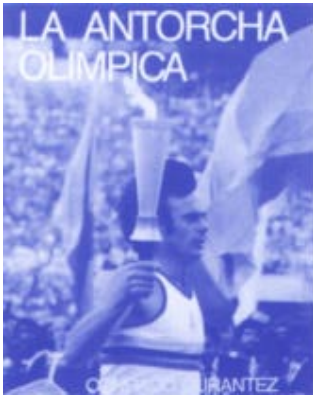

Bibliography



LA ANTORCHA OLÍMPICA (The Olympic Torch), by Conrado Durán-tez, published by the Spanish Olympic Committee, Núñez de Balboa 120, 28006 Madrid (ESP). 195 pages in Spanish.

“Within the inexhaustible wealth which Olympic philosophy offers, Conrado Durán-tez has succeeded in tracing the blurred outlines of the Olympic torch at the origin of the Games in Ancient Greece, with all the symbolism that the modern Olympic Games have ascribed to the flame which, lit at Olympia, has illuminated the modern world with its unifying quality of human warmth and its enduring message of peace”, (preface by the President of the IOC). This book, the first of a series entitled “Olympia”, reminds us throughout its 195 pages of the philosophy surrounding the Olympic symbol, and offers us a detailed account of the journey of the Olympic flame, and the accompanying ceremony, for the Olympic Games from 1936 until 1992. Numerous excellent photographs, maps and amusing drawings illustrate this new work by the President of the Spanish Olympic Academy.

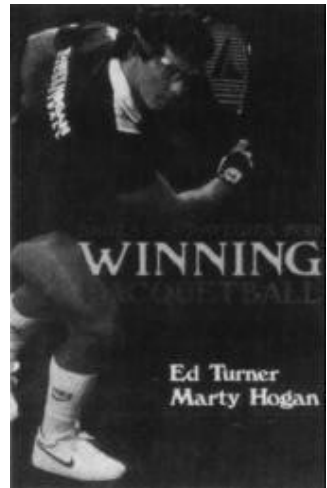
MYTHS, MODELS, METHODS IN SPORT PEDAGOGY, edited by Gary T. Barrette, Ronald S. Feingold, C. Roger Rees and Maurice Pieron, published by Human Kinetics Publishers Inc., Box 5076, Champaign, Illinois 61820 (USA), 1987. 288 pages in English. Price : US \$28.—.

This work is made up of 28 texts presented to the world sports conference in 1985, organised by the international Association of Higher Institutes of Physical Education (ADELPHI), the main theme of which was “an international dialogue on research in sport and physical education”. The authors have explored the myths existing in research on the problems of technology, the relationship between games and culture and the introduction of sports sociology in physical education. Suggestions and definitions of personalised instruction methods, ethnographic research and other qualitative and quantitative approaches to research in the field of sports pedagogy add to the considerable interest of this work.

L'ÉTOILE SUR LES TOILES (The star in pictures), edited by the Galerie Stanislas, 21 bis, rue Saint-Dizier, 54000 Nancy (FRA). 50 pages in French.



This book brings together the works of 45 world famous artists who from 30th October until 15th November 1987 paid tribute to Michel Platini and football. “More than an exhibition, it is an important event which brings together sport and the arts”.

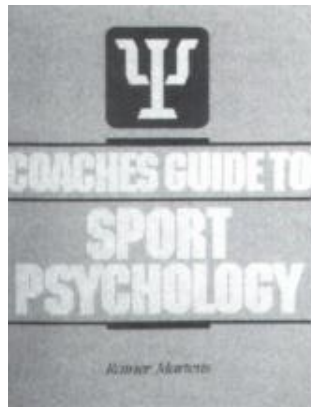

This guide presents and analyses all the problems of motivation, communication and tension which sometimes confront the coach and the athlete. Better relations and an improvement in sports performance will be the benefits of this new psychological approach to sport.
