

DONATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE IOC, A PRIZE FOR SPORTS SCIENCE IN 1989

The International Council for Physical Education and Sports Science (ICPESS), in agreement with the IOC, will award the "IOC President's Prize for Sports Science" as of 1989.

Each year, outstanding individual or collective scientific projects will receive the award, which will be presented alternately within the area of bio-medical science one year and that of human or social sciences or sport and physical education the next. It may concern studies on the development of the Olympic and sports movement in the world and its impact on peace and international understanding, significant contributions to research into physical and sports education, evaluations of the effect of the practice of sport on the development of personality, or health, or even projects which benefit the future evolution of sports science and its various disciplines.

This prize, which will be of US \$7,000 plus a commemorative medal and a diploma, will be allocated by a jury consisting of five international experts nominated by the Executive Committee of ICPESS. It

will be awarded during its General Meetings, in the presence of an IOC representative.

The award-winning projects will be published by the ICPESS.

Next year, the prize will be awarded in the area of bio-medical science. Conditions for participation in the "IOC President's Sports Science Prize 1989":

THE PROJECTS SUBMITTED

- must not have been published before submission ;
- must be written in French or English (exceptionally, work in other languages will be accepted after prior consultation with the General Secretariat of ICPESS);
- theses from universities or other higher educational institutions must have been passed by the teaching authorities concerned.

The dossier must include:

- the name address, and scientific curriculum vitae of the author(s).
- a written declaration certifying that the project has been carried out independently by the author and that only filed documentation has been used.

Ten copies of each dossier must be sent before the date limit for submissions of 30th June 1989 (beyond this date, no dossiers will be accepted), to:
