

## NEW TROPHY FOR THE MUSEUM

**T**he collections of the Olympic Museum have recently been enriched by the arrival of a new item by Carl Fabergé. The donor was the collector and great art lover Pierre Sciclounoff, a Geneva lawyer, who presented the IOC with a unique piece in solid silver, the work of Carl Fabergé the famous goldsmith and jeweller who exercised his talents for the imperial Russian court at the turn of the century.

This sports trophy, presented by the donor to President Samaranch on 6th February, will go to join another item by Faberge which the Museum already possesses, a silver trophy given by Czar Nicholas II on the occasion of the Games of the Vth Olympiad in 1912 in Stockholm.
