OFFICIAL REPORT AND FILM OF THE GAMES

The official report and film of the Games of the XXIV Olympiad in Seoul were officially presented by the Korean Sports Minister Mr Kim Jip and by the President of the Seoul Olympic Sports Promotion Foundation who had preceded him in SLOOC, Mr Kim Ock Jin, at the meeting of the Executive Board. On this occasion, the IOC President expressed his warmest thanks : "This is indeed the most important document that we have ever had on the Games and I would like to express, on behalf of myself and the entire Olympic Movement, our most sincere thanks. May I also

take this opportunity to congratulate you and all those who have worked so hard in producing it, again on behalf of the whole Olympic family. This report, I cannot stress enough, is of invaluable worth to the IOC and, indeed, to all future organizers of the Games. With the conclusion of this report, you have closed an edition of the Olympic Games which had such an enormous success and which really can be considered as the best Games which have ever taken place".
