SOLIDARITY: INSTRUCTORS In LAUSANNE

A refresher course for course-directors of the Itinerant School for Sports Administrators in Francophone Africa was held in Lausanne on 8th and 9th April last. This was a working encounter in the company of Mr Anselmo Lopez, Director of Solidarity, and the Solidarity staff, at which views were exchanged, experiences recounted and difficulties raised. The meeting was also intended to clarify the rules to be followed in Solidarity. The participants visited the site of the future Olympic Museum and the Olympic Villa, headquarters of the Court of Arbitration for Sport, where CAS Secretary-General Mr Gilbert Schwaar explained to them how the institution works and the useful role it plays in resolving conflicts between different bodies in sport. This useful lesson was greatly appreciated by the visitors, who were received at the end of their two-day visit by the IOC President at Olympic House.

An identical seminar is scheduled for course directors for the English-speaking areas of Africa and Asia on 3rd and 4th June.
